Clearly label trash containers where waste is produced. Ensure timely collection and disposal.



Walking Surfaces & Aisleways

Use anti-slip flooring and ensure adequate lighting. Replace any worn or damaged areas.



Hazardous Materials

Where hazardous products are handled, prohibit smoking, eating, and drinking.



Material & Product Storage

Clearly mark all storage areas. Keep aisles, stairs and exits free of obstructions, and follow fire codes.



Lighting

Use clean, energy-efficient lighting and properly maintain all fixtures.
